APPLICATION AND USE

Preparation Remove dust by using a vacuum or dry compressed air while wiping surface with dry, clean cotton cloths.

Method Surface should be cleaned using the "Two Cloth Cleaning Method". Soak one cloth in 600 Wipe Down Solvent and use

this to wet the surface. Quickly wipe with a dry second cloth to remove the contaminants. The solvent must not be allowed to dry on the surface. Work small areas at a time, so that the second cloth wipes it clean and dry. Repeat until all

residue is removed, changing cloths frequently.

Hints Other Using only one set of cloths or one wet cloth only smears contamination around. Any sanding residue left on the

surface can impair the finish.

Compatibility/Substrates Do not use as a thinner or reducer
